# What is UNESP

Along with **University of Sao Paulo** (USP, est. 1934) and **University of Campinas** (UNICAMP, est. 1962), **Sao Paulo State University** (UNESP, est. 1976) is one of the three universities from SP state **government**

**Brazil**: 10,000 PhD/year (data from 2011)

**USP**: 23%, **UNICAMP**: 8%

**UNESP** and **UFRJ**: 7% each

# Who is UNESP (data from 2015)

More than 30 HEI spread in 24 different cities  
37,700 students in 155 undergraduate programs  
13,541 students in 255 graduate programs  
3,826 professors, 6,782 administrative staff  
7,037 papers (SCOPUS and WOS) and 30 libraries

Budget (2015): R\$2.6 billions (85% from SP gov.)


# What is FEG
